Ordered, that the clerk of the council, purchase four sets of Killy's Laws two of which are to be forwarded to the Hon.^{ble} the Secretary of State for the use of his Department, one to the Athenaeum Society in Philadelphia and one to the American Antiquarian Society in Massachusetts.
