

By the Executive of Maryland;

Ordered, that the Armourer at Frederick Town deliver to Captain James T Houston or to his order in good and sufficient Condition sixty stand of Arms and accoutrements for the use of the company of Infantry called the "First Frederick Guards" under his command, upon Captain Houston's producing to him a certificate from Grafton Duvall of his having entered into Bond with approved security to the State of Maryland, for the safe keeping and return of said Arms and accoutrements in like good order when required by the proper authority; the said Bond to be lodged with the Clerk of the Executive Council to be filed with the papers of the Department.

In Council Annapolis June 14 1820

Ordered, that the Armourer at Frederick Town deliver to Captain Thomas Quaintrell or to his order in good and sufficient Condition one hundred stand of Muskets and accoutrements for the use of the Uniform Company commanded by him upon Captain Quaintrell's producing to him a certificate from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> John Buchanan of his having entered into Bond with approved security to the State of Maryland, for the safe keeping and return of said Arms and accoutrements in like good order when required by the proper authority; the said Bond to be lodged with the Clerk of the Executive Council to be filed with the papers of the Department.

Ordered, that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Samuel Wickes or to his order in good and sufficient Condition seventy five stand of muskets and accoutrements for the use of the Company commanded by him upon Captain Wickes's producing to him a certificate from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Judge Morrill of his having entered into Bond with approved security to the State of Maryland, for the safe keeping and return of the said Arms and accoutrements in like good order when required by the proper authority; the said Bond to be lodged with the Clerk of the Executive Council to be filed with the papers of the Department.

Ordered, that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Benjamin Brookes or to his order in good and sufficient Condition
