

Sixty three Rifles and accoutrements for the use of the company,  
Commanded by him upon Captain Brooks producing to him a certificate  
from the Hon<sup>ble</sup>: Thomas H. Wilkinson of his having entered into Bond with  
approved security to the State of Maryland, for the safe keeping and  
return of said Arms and accoutrements in like good order when required  
by the proper authority, the said Bond to be lodged with the clerk of the  
Executive Council to be filed with the papers of this Department.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John  
Sullivan four dollars and twelve and a half cents for sweeping the State  
House Chimneys as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lewis Price  
Pay master to the forty ninth Regiment the sum of one hundred and fifty  
dollars and two cents the amount of the following Pay Roll and account  
to wit, The Artillery Company commanded by Captain Damsell for  
services in Cecil County in July 1814 one hundred and forty four dollars  
and two cents and Captain Damsell's own account for rations due for  
said service six dollars.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James  
Munroe one hundred and seven dollars and fourteen cents for Postages  
as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Alpheus Dodge  
nine dollars and fifty cents for mending the State House pump as per  
account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William  
D. Bell four dollars and sixty two and a half cents for publishing Pro-  
clamations &c as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William  
Lorman two hundred and sixty dollars for rent of office for Lottery Commissioners  
out of any money which may be in the Treasury arising from lotteries and  
from no other fund as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Albany  
Jump Agent for the collection of the public Arms four hundred and thirty one.
