

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jehu Chandler Esquire, four hundred and fifty, four dollars and fifty cents for printing, Elected Laws, retailers licences, marriage licences &c &c as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thompson one hundred and fifty dollars the balance of his account for distributing the laws and votes and Proceedings of the Genl Assembly, December session 1819 to the several Counties on the Western Shore as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lambert Clayland two hundred dollars for distributing the laws and votes and Proceedings of the General Assembly, December Session 1819 to the several Counties on the Eastern Shore, as per account passed & filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lovegrove Dell and Co. out of any money which may be in the Treasury arising from Lotteries and from no other funds eight dollars for a Record &c for Lottery commissioners as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thompson nine dollars for a Desk &c for the Council Room as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that Washington G Tuck Armourer at Annapolis be allowed at the rate of seventy five cents per musket for cleaning eleven hundred and seventy muskets in the old armoury, and that he be paid at the rate of one dollar per stand for repairing four hundred and seventy muskets in the said Armoury.

Ordered, that the Armourer at Annapolis be allowed the sum of five hundred dollars per annum for his services as Armourer, and for receiving, delivering out, taking care of & keeping clean the arms and other property of the State under his charge.

Ordered, that the Armourer at Fredericks Town be allowed the sum of three hundred dollars per annum for his services as Armourer, and for receiving, delivering out, taking care of & keeping clean the arms and other property of the State under his charge.
