The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Hon<sup>ble</sup> James Stabb, James Butcher, John Stephen & Thomas H Wilkinson.

James Summers was on the nomination of His Excellency the Governor appointed an additional Justice of the Peace for Frederick County.

Ordered, that Mr Washington G Suck be employed to go to Baltimore and receive from Mr Allen Dorsey, Agent at Baltimore all the Arms and other military stores under his care & pass his receipt for the same and cause one thousand stand of the best muskets and accoutrements to be forwarded on the best terms to the Armourer at Frederick Town and that he transport the residue of the Arms and military stores to Annapolis and place the same in the Armoury at this place.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry M Murray Esquire District Attorney for the sixth Judicial District of Maryland three hundred dollars it being a compensation allowed him by the Executive for attending to and bringing to a favourable issue certain suits in Baltimore County Court "The State vs the Surgical Institution Lottery."

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Green Esquire five hundred dollars under a Resolution of the General Assembly for printing the new compilation of the Laws of Maryland to be accounted for.
