

Ordered, that the Honourable Nathaniel Williams Assistant Attorney General. be employed to assist the District Attorney for the sixth Judicial District of Maryland in the prosecution of certain actions brought by the State of Maryland in Baltimore County Court against the managers of the Medical College Lottery in the City of Baltimore to recover the amount of the tax imposed by act of Assembly passed at December Session 1817. Chapter 154.

The following Letter was written

Council Chamber Annapolis June 15. 1820

Gentlemen

The Executive have directed me to inform you, that they have selected you to examine into the State of the Armoury at Easton. They will therefore esteem it a favour if you will be pleased to state to them the number of arms that are in the Armoury, the number that appear to want cleaning and what you suppose would be a reasonable compensation to any person for putting them in order. The Executive cannot without ad fidem with certainty on a right compensation to be given to the person who may be employed by them to clean them.
