

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. James Munroe fifty four dollars and seventy four cents for postages for the Executive Department, and Treasurer as per account passed & filed.

By the Petition of Davis B Parke and Michael Withers accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Baltimore, County, it appears that they entered into a recognizance in the sum of two hundred dollars for the appearance of Davis B Parke at the said Court on the third Monday in September 1819. to answer an Assault and Battery. The Petitioners state that the said Davis B Parke while attending the said Court was called from home by the indisposition of his wife; that he was thrown from his horse and sustained considerable injury, which together with the indisposition of his wife prevented him from returning to the said Court, as there has not been a failure of Justice the Court recommend a remission of the said forfeiture. The Board do order and direct that the said Davis B Parke and Michael Withers be released from the same.
