Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to General Perry Benson sixty dollars for one quarters half pay due the first Instant; under the provisions of the Act of Assembly passed at a November session seventeen hundred and eighty five, Entitled, an act for the relief of certain maimed officers.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Thomas Henrice one hundred and fifty dollars for six months salary as Armourer at Easton due the thirteenth Ultimo...

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John N^o Watkins Esquire, thirty seven dollars and fifty cents for one quarters salary as clerk of the Senate due the first Instant.
