Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Thomas Karney, one hundred and twenty five dollars, for one quarters salary as Auditor General, due the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August last.

Wednesday, October 18<sup>th</sup> 1820

The Council met (Present His Excellency the Governor and the Hon<sup>ble</sup>. James Nabb, Grafton Duvall and John Stephen.)

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Smith, thirty one dollars and fifty cents, for printing, as per account passed and filed.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jacob Troxall, of Frederick County, or order, three hundred dollars, it being the amount of valuation, that was put on negro Jimmy, slave of said Jacob Troxall, sentenced by Frederick County Court on the twentieth of May last to be hung, for arson, and which sentence was commuted by the Governor the thirteenth day of June last, to transportation out of the United States, there to be sold as a slave for life for the benefit of the State of Maryland.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Raphaelle Peale, twenty dollars, for Varnishing the Portrait of General Washington in the House of Delegates room, as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Wello, fifteen dollars, for one quarters rent of Magazine up to the twelfth day of July last, as per account passed and filed.
