Sprigg, esquires, were elected for the fourth District: Elias Brown, esquire, was elected for the fifth District: John Formood, esquire, was elected for the sixth District: William R. Stuart, Esquire, was elected for the seventh District: John Boon, esquire, was elected for the eighth District: and Joshua Pideaux, esquire was elected for the ninth District. Given in Council, at the City of Annapolis, under the Great Seal of the State of Maryland, this fourth day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty.

Ordered, That the foregoing Proclamation be published in the Maryland Republican, Annapolis; the American and Patriot, Baltimore; the Eastern Star, Eastern, Talbot County.

Stuart, John Boon and Joshua Pideaux esquires are duly elected Electors on the part of this State to choose a President and vice President of the United States.
