Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Smith, fourteen
dollars, for publishing laws respecting small notes and so forth, as per account pas-

Ordered, that Mr Washington G. Tuck be employed to cover the Table in the Court
of Appeals room, with green cloth, and that he cause fifteen yards of carpeting to be
made up, and put down in the said room, the whole expense not to exceed one hundred
and one dollars - and also have such plastering done as may be necessary over the stove
-case leading to the said Apartments.
