Sir

I have received information that Thomas Swin who has been charged by the affidavit of Bushrod M. Marriott of Stealing Sundry Bank Notes the property of the said B. M. Marriott has fled from the Justice of this State and is now confined in the Jail of Philadelphia in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It has therefore devolved on me in the name of the Executive Authority of the State of Maryland, to demand of your Excellency, agreeably to the act of Congress passed on the 12th day of February 1793 respecting fugitives from Justice, and persons escaping from the service of their Masters the said Thomas Swin, and to request that he be delivered to Mr William O'Hara, who has been duly Appointed Agent on the part of the Executive Authority of the State of Maryland, to receive and remove the said Thomas Swin to this State having Jurisdiction of the offence with which he is charged. For your Excellency's satisfaction, I have enclosed you the affidavit upon which this Application is grounded which has been taken by the proper officer. I have the Honor to be, with great respect
