The Honorable Nicholas Brewer Appeared in the Council Room

The State of Maryland to the Sheriff of Frederick County

Greeting Whereas it has been represented to the Executive of this State by the Executives of the Commonwealth of Virginia that a certain George Saylor charged with stealing a Horse and other Articles the property of William Lexter of Frederick City in the Commonwealth of Virginia by the Affidavit of the said William Lexter which affidavit is stated to be authentic has fled from the Justice of the said Commonwealth and is now confined in the Jail of Frederick County in this State. And the Honorable Peter W. Daniel Lieutenant Governor of the said Commonwealth of Virginia hath in the absence of the Governor in pursuance of the Constitution and Laws of the United States demanded the said George Saylor as a fugitive from Justice. You are therefore hereby commanded to deliver the said George Saylor to Mr Peter Bremer who has been duly appointed Agent to receive him and to remove him to the said State of Virginia having Jurisdiction of the offence with which he is charged provided the said George Saylor is not charged with having violated any of the Laws of this State and provided also that the said Peter Bremer do first pay and discharge all costs arising on the commitment and confinement of the said George Saylor. Given under my hand and the Seal of the State of Maryland this eighth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three
