By the Petition of Richard Bell accompanied by a transcript from  
the Proceedings of Baltimore County Court it appears that he was fined by  
Balt<sup>y</sup> County Court, at September Term 1823, in two cases the sum of sixteen dollars  
in each case for selling spirituous liquors without license. The Petitioner states that  
he has kept a Tavern for a number of years, and regularly took out a license  
until the March Term of the said Court 1821 at which time he sent down the  
Money by one of his friends as he had been in the habit of doing, for the purpose  
of obtaining a license when he was informed the Court had adjourned and  
that he was too late. The Petitioner further states that at the September Term  
1821 he took out license but having sold liquor between the March & September  
Term he was presented and fined as aforesaid that as the circumstances.
