

Ordered That the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Thomas Franklin forty Pickers and Brushes and eight Gun screws for the use of the Company commanded by him.

By the Petition of William Barber, of Montgomery County, accompanied by a Transcript from the proceedings of the Court of the said County at March Term 1822. it appears that he together with Hezekiah Appleby and Joseph Bryan, entered into a Recognizance the said William Barber in the sum of fifty dollars, and the said Hezekiah Appleby and Joseph Bryan in the sum of thirty dollars each, for the appearance of the said William Barber at the said Court to answer a presentment. And it appearing from the Statement of a number of respectable persons, who are well acquainted with the said Barber, that the said Barber has suffered the said Recognizance to be forfeited more from ignorance than with a view to fly from Justice. And it appearing further from said Statement, that the said Barber has been for a long time in confinement for the same, a dead expense to the said County, without the least prospect of his being able to discharge the same. The Board on consideration of which circumstances, and from the Recommendation of the Court of the said County, release the said William Barber, Hezekiah Appleby and Joseph Bryan from the said forfeitures.
