Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Gauer Esquire three  
hundred and seventy two, eighty seven and an half cents, for publishing Proclamation for  
the apprehension of Robert H. Johnson, Publishing Militia Law, Resolution respecting  
Penitents, and Printing Blank Returns for the Adjutant General as per account papered.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Williams  
Sheriff of Saint Marys County seventy two dollars and forty two cents, for clothes for  
Negro Joe whose sentence of death had been commuted to transportation, passage to Bal-  
timore, Rail fees, and his own personal expenses, as per account papered.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to \_\_\_\_\_ Editor of  
The Charleston City Gazette twenty dollars for two years subscription to said Paper up to July  
next, as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isaac Marves sixty  
seven dollars and ten cents, for Publishing Militia Law, Resolution appointing a day of  
humiliation and Prayer &c. &c. as per account papered and filed.
