

By the Petition of Thomas Wimer of Somerset County, accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County, it appears, that he was fined by the said Court, two thousand weight of Tobacco, at April term eighteen hundred and twenty four, for receiving one half Bushel of Corn from Ogea Samuel, slave of James Holt. The Petitioner states that he had lately come into the neighbourhood, and was not acquainted with the slaves and free negroes residing there, that on being applied to by said Ogea Samuel, and not knowing at the time that he was a slave, he sold him a pair of shoes, and received the corn in part payment, and the said Court having stated their belief of the truth of the facts, and recommended a remission of the said fine, The Board do order and direct that the said Thomas Wimer be released from so much of the said fine as the State is entitled to.

By the Petition of Archibald Edmonston, of Prince Georges County, accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County, it appears that he entered recognizance with, Col. ma. L. Beall and Henry Culver his securities, himself in the sum of fifty Pounds, and his securities on the sum of twenty five Pounds each, for the appearance of the said Archibald Edmonston at Prince Georges County Court, at September term 1822, to answer a charge of assaulting and beating Jacob Saunders, and to keep the Peace. The Petitioner states that the said Jacob Saunders did not appear, and that he the Petitioner was prevented from attending Court, from a severe illness, The Petitioner states that he had met them, nor ever had any disposition to violate the public peace. The Board do on the consideration of the circumstances of this case, and from the recommendation of the said Court release the said Archibald Edmonston and his securities from the said forfeitures.
