

Law, as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James G. Wheeler sixty four dollars for transmitting laws and acts and Proceedings for December Session 1823 to the Clerks of the several Counties on the Eastern Shore, it being the amount allowed him by the Executive.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to J. A. Bingham fifty two dollars for Publishing Resolution appointing a day of humiliation and Prayer, Law relative to the disciplining the Militia, and resolution respecting persons, as per account papered & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jeremiah Hughes one hundred and twenty eight dollars and fifty cents for copies of Laws to be transmitted to the Executives of the different States, to the Secretary of State of the United States, and then to the Heads of State warehouses. Publishing the Law respecting the Meeting of the Legislatures, and for two years subscription to the Maryland Republican as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jeremiah Hughes eleven dollars and fifty cents for two Reams of Paper and an hundred quills as per account papered.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain John T. Barber six dollars and seventeen cents for freight from Baltimore on seventy four Muskets and two Boxes as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward J. Coak one dollar it being the amount paid by him on two Boxes containing Laws of Kentucky as per account.
