by him. The expense of transportation to be borne by said Hanson.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Mills fifty  
dollars for one Quarter Rent of Magazine due the 3<sup>d</sup> Instant under contract with  
the Executive.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Henea  
three hundred dollars for one Years Salary as Amourer at Eastern due the 15<sup>th</sup> of  
April last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jeremiah Hughes  
one thousand dollars, the amount allowed him for printing the Laws and votes and  
Proceedings of the Legislature for December Session 1823 as per contract with the Executive.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Ander-  
son sixty dollars for one Quarters half pay due him the 1<sup>st</sup> of May last under the  
provisions of an act of Assembly passed at November Session 1785.

Ordered that William Hilly Esquire be appointed to make an Index to  
the Laws of Maryland from December Session 18 to 1823 inclusive, and that the same  
be printed by Jeremiah Hughes under his direction.
