Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John D. Spencer or order forty nine dollars for publishing in his paper by order of the Executive & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Mackey or order seven dollars twenty three cents for Postage for His Excellency the Governor & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Major Thomas Farney or order seventy five dollars twelve cents for balance of his account as agent for bringing John Peters alias Conners a fugitive from Justice, from the State of Virginia, after deducting three hundred dollars heretofore advanced as & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Hughey or order one hundred dollars for printing Blank Licences, and publishing in his paper by order of the Executive, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jonas Green or order forty dollars for publishing in his paper by order of the Executive & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George Shaw or order thirty two dollars and twenty eight cents for Stationary & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jany Sewall Esq. or order two hundred dollars for expence of the Witnesses attending the trial of John Peters alias Conners charged with the Murder of Evelina Cunningham, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George Stubbings or order thirty two dollars for attending at Battinow, Harpers Ferry and Stafford Court House in Virginia against the supposed Murderer of Evelina Cunningham, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Thompson or order four dollars and sixty seven and half cents for Stationary & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Alexander Graham or order thirty dollars twenty five cents for publishing in his paper by order of the Executive & amount allowed.
