

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Thomas
or order eight Dollars thirty six cents for repairs to the Armory at Easton
and moving Cannon & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Manshiff
or order two dollars and twenty five cents for repairing Chair for Council Chamber
and covering Desk in committee room of the House of Delegates, & amount
allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Munroe
Esq or order one hundred and four dollars fifty one half cents for one quarter
Postage up to the 30th September last for the Executive, Adjutant General and
Treasurer, & amount allowed.

Wednesday December 7 1825.

Christian Mayer Esq of the City of Baltimore having
procured to His Excellency the Governor, an Exequatur from the President
of the United States recognizing him as consul General of the King of
Wurtemberg to reside at the said City of Baltimore. Whereupon His
Excellency ordered that the said Act of recognition be published in
the Maryland Republican and Gazette of Annapolis; The Patriot, American
and Gazette of Baltimore; The Political Examiner of Frederick Town,
the Maryland Herald of Georgetown; The Star of Easton, and the National
Intelligencer of Washington. The following is the order issued by His
Excellency viz.

To all whom it may concern
Christian Mayer Esq having procured to me an Exequatur signed
by the President of the United States, and sealed with the seal of the said
State, recognizing him as consul general of the King of Wurtemberg
to reside at Baltimore. Ordered that the said recognition be published
for the information and government of the people of this State.
