Saturday December 31 1825.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington of Ind. Esq or order twelve dollars and fifty cents for one quarters salary for taking care of the public property and the 20th October last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Grafton Munroe Administrator of James Munroe late Post Master, fifty seven dollars forty nine and a half cents the amount of postage up to the 12th of Nov 1825.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay His Excellency Samuel Stevens twenty six dollars nine and a half cents, the amount of his expenses while transacting business of the State.
