

The Senate and House of Delegates, having jointly recommended, George M. Richberger Esquire as Register of Wills for Frederick County; Frederick Wilson Esquire as Register of Wills for Kent County; William O. Merrick Esquire as Register of Wills for Charley County; and James Langston as Register of Wills for Caroline County. His Excellency Commissioned each of the said Gentlemen to the respective offices for which they were severally recommended.

Thursday January 12 1826

His Excellency The Governor appeared in the Council Chamber. The Honble William Stenard and Daniel Martin members of the Council, elected, appeared in the Council Chamber, this day and qualified before Joseph Mayo Esquire a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County, by severally and respectively taking the Oaths required by the Constitution of the United States, and the Constitution and Laws of this State, and subscribing a declaration of their belief in the Christian Religion.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Culbreth or order three hundred and seventy five dollars for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Council due the 11th Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order eighty seven dollars fifty cents for one quarters salary as Messenger to the Council due the 8th Instant.

Friday January 13th 1826
