The following Order was issued by His Excellency the Governor, upon the
demand and information and evidence therein mentioned, being received. Viz.
State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Washington County, Greeting.
Whereas it appears from authentic documents, certified and transmitted to
the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency John Andrew Shulze
Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain Christian Detrick late of the
County of Franklin in the said State, stands charged on oath with the crime of Horse
Stealing, committed in the said County, and that he has fled from the justice of the said
State of Pennsylvania into this State, and is now in your custody confined in
the Jail at Hagerstown. And whereas the said John Andrew Shulze Governor
aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases, by the Constitution
and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Christian Detrick of the Executive
Authority of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed Archibald Fleming
Esquire, of the aforesaid County of Franklin, his agent to receive the said fugitive, and
convey him back to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial upon the aforesaid
charge. Now, therefore, I Joseph Kent Governor of the State of Maryland,
hath thought proper to comply with the said demand, and do hereby, order and
direct that you deliver the said Christian Detrick to Archibald Fleming, agent as
aforesaid, provided he is not charged in your custody for any violation of the Laws
of this State, upon the said agent forth paying all costs of the arrest, imprisonment
&c of the said Christian Detrick - For which this shall be your sufficient
Warrant. Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the said State,

Whereof, in compliance with a demand of
His Excellency John Andrew Shulze Governor of the State of Pennsylvania,
a certain Christian Detrick, who stands charged on oath with the crime of

been ordered to be delivered to Archibald Fleming, Esquire, of the said County,
the duly authorized agent, of His Excellency, as a fugitive from Justice, for the
purpose of being removed to the said State of Pennsylvania, for trial upon the
aforesaid charge, according to Law. Now, therefore, all persons within
the State of Maryland are hereby required and enjoined to let the said
Archibald Fleming, agent as aforesaid, pass with the said prisoner unmolested
to the said State of Pennsylvania; he the said Archibald Fleming conduct
himself in a peaceable and orderly manner, and using no improper
severity or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.
