

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Grafton Munroe Esq: or order eighty two dollars twenty five cents, for his account of postage from the 5<sup>th</sup> of October to the 31<sup>st</sup> of December last viz \$36.44 for the Executive, \$12.12 for the Adjutant General and \$13.68 for the Treasurer - amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Nathl. Spier and Verbot or order sixty nine dollars fifty cents, viz \$34 for publishing Exequatur of British Major General of the Kingdom of Wurttemberg, \$60 for publishing the act providing for the public instruction of youth, and the several acts proposing alterations in the Constitution, \$3 for publishing Exequatur of G. A. Hankin Bremen Consul, and \$3.50 for publishing Proclamation of Benjamin Buckmaster - amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay John M. Buchanan or order seventy nine dollars fifty cents, viz \$8 for advertising State Lands for sale, \$45 for publishing act providing for the public instruction of youth, \$21.25 for publishing act providing for alterations in the Constitution, and \$5.25 for publishing Proclamation of Benjamin Buckmaster - amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Isaac Munroe or order sixteen dollars, viz \$2 for advertising Exequatur of Bremen Consul, \$3 for publishing Proclamation of Benjamin Buckmaster, \$3 for publishing Proclamation of Congressional Election, and \$8 for subscription to the Baltimore Patriot from the 2<sup>nd</sup> of December 1825 to the 2<sup>nd</sup> of December 1826 - amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Nathaniel Mitchell or order seven dollars for publishing Proclamation of Benjamin Buckmaster - amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay John Shaw or order thirty five dollars for one year Rent of Gun House ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 1826 - amount allowed.
