David Ridgely Esquire, Librarian, in virtue of the act intitled an act establishing a Library for the use of the Legislature, passed at the present session of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Grafton Monroe Esquire or order ninety six dollars forty nine cents for postage for the Executive, Adjutant General and Treasurers from the 3^d day of January to the 12th Instant, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Tuck or order fifty five dollars thirty seven and half cents viz \$34, for firing Salutes on the qualification of the Governor and on the Anniversary of the Birth Day of Washington, and \$21.37½ for sundry repairs about the State House and public property. of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Tuck or order two hundred dollars, on account of the repair of Chimes to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John McComb Esquire or order six dollars for publishing proclamation of Benjamin Buckmaster of amount allowed.
