Instant, and sentenced to pay a fine of ten dollars, and undergo a confinement
of ten days in the public jail of said County - said Court ordered to the

The following Order was issued by His Excellency the Governor,
upon the demand and information and evidence therein mentioned viz

The State of Maryland to wit. To the Sheriff of Worcester County
greeting. Whereby it appears from authentic documents certified and transmitted
to the Executive Department of this State by His Excellency John Andrew
Shulze Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain John Purnell,
alias Isaac Purnell alias John Smith alias James Morris, has been
detained by the grand Inquest of the said State of Pennsylvania, enquiring for
the City of Philadelphia for the crime of kidnapping a certain male light
coloured negro the name of whom was to the said inquest unknown, contrary
to the form of the act of the General Assembly of this State in such case
made and provided, and that the said John Purnell alias Isaac Purnell,
alias John Smith alias James Morris, has fled from the justice of the said
State into this State, and within your jurisdiction. And whereas the
said John Andrew Shulze Governor as aforesaid, acts in pursuance of the
authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United
States, demanded the said John Purnell, alias Isaac Purnell alias
John Smith alias James Morris, of the Executive of this State, as a
fugitive from justice, and appointed Samuel P. Garrigue high Constable
of the said City of Philadelphia his agent to receive the said fugitive
and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania, for trial for said
crime. In view, therefore, I Joseph Kent Governor of the State of
Maryland have thought proper, in compliance with the said demand, to
order and direct the arrest and delivery of the said fugitive, and do hereby
order and direct that you forthwith arrest the said John Purnell, alias
Isaac Purnell, alias John Smith alias James Morris, if he is to be found
in your bailiwick, and deliver him to the said Samuel P. Garrigue agent
as aforesaid, he the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest of. For
which this shall be your sufficient warrant.

thousand eight hundred and twenty seven, and of the
Independence of the United States the fifty first.
