

Ordered that the Clerk of the Council cause the small room adjoining the Council Chamber to be fitted up with shelves & in a plain manner, for a Library as provided for by Law

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain James Keppel 50 fifty Muskets and accoutrements for the use of the company under his command.

In pursuance of a Resolution of the Legislature passed at December Session 1824 in ordered that the State House be copied with slate in a workmanlike manner and with the best materials provided the same can be done for a sum of money not exceeding one thousand and seventy dollars. And it is further ordered that the aforesaid work be done under the super-intendance of Washington G. Truitt

Ordered that Washington G. Truitt be and hereby is, authorized to purchase a National Flag for the use of the State.

On the Nomination of His Excellency the Governor and by and with the advice and consent of the Council Henry Thompson was appointed to distribute the Index to the Laws from 1819 to 1825 inclusive, made by William Kelly Esquire and also Harris & Johnsons Report, to the several authorities and persons entitled to receive the said respective works, and also to deliver to the Levy Courts of the several Counties of the State the weights and measures so obtained under an Act of the General Assembly passed at December Session 1825

The following order of instruction to the Commissioners appointed to assess certain property in the City of Baltimore under an Act of the General Assembly passed at the last Session, entitled "An Act to provide for the Valuation and Condemnation of certain real estate in the City of Baltimore" was passed and ordered to be transmitted to the Commissioners therein named viz
Whereas it is provided by an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at its last Session, entitled "An Act to provide for the Valuation and Condemnation of certain real estate in the City of Baltimore" that Solomon Etting, William Lorman, David Winchester, Talbot Jones and Benjamin C. Howard, or a majority of them are appointed Commissioners and hereby authorized and empowered, upon giving ten days notice in two of the daily Newspapers printed in the City of Baltimore, of their intention to proceed under the provisions of this Act to value and assess so much of the Land lying South of Pratt Street, between Market's Square Dock and Connelly's Dock, with the improvements thereon in the City of Baltimore, as under the direction of the Governor and Council they may deem proper and necessary to perfect the design as contemplated by the Act of December Session 1825 Chapter 159, including such portion of the ground and appurtenances as the Governor and Council may deem necessary for a public street or necessary convenience for public use, and shall by their order, certified by the Clerk of the Council, direct the said Commissioners to value and assess the same. It is, therefore, hereby ordered, that the Commissioners aforesaid upon giving the notice required by Law proceed under the provisions of the Act above recited to value and assess all the Land described in the Plot herewith sent, beginning at the Water in the Basin at
