

1, and running thence bounding with the Water to red figure 2, thence to red figure 3, thence to the Water of Market Space to red figure 4, thence bounding with the Water in said Dock to the beginning: extending the said premises as far into the adjacent waters as the present Proprietors have a right to go, and including all the improvements, rights, privileges and appurtenances thereunto appertaining.

Upon application being made to His Excellency the Governor stating that a certain Negro man named Frederick, Slave of Robert M. Bower Esquire of Prince Georges County, has been committed and is now in the Jail of said County charged with having committed a Rape upon the body of a certain Eliza Bromning, a white Girl not quite eight years old, and that the purposes of Justice require that the said Negro Frederick should be brought to trial therefor before the regular term of Prince Georges County Court - a special Commission of Oyer and Terminer and general Goal delivery was issued directed to John Stephen Esquire Chief Judge and Edmund Keyser and John R. Plater Esquires associate Judges, of the said judicial district of this State, authorizing and requiring the said Judges to hold a Court at Upper Marlborough in Prince Georges County aforesaid, on the first Monday the twenty eighth Instant, and from thence by adjournment from day to day as may be found necessary for the trial of the said Negro Frederick, and all other crimes, offenses and Misdemeanors whatsoever that have arisen or may arise in the said County, and for the delivery of the Jail of said County of all the prisoners confined therein charged with any crime offense or Misdemeanor whatsoever.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Cook or order one hundred and forty two dollars forty one cents viz \$11.50 for repairs of the public building \$78.37 for Boney to pack the Votes and proceedings and the Laws, and \$12.50 for one quarter Salary for taking care of the public property, in amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Rezin Spurrier or order one dollar and fifty six cents for sweeping chimneys in the State and Government Houses, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard Anderson or order two hundred and forty dollars for one year pension due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Wilson Nichols or order fifty dollars for one quarter Salary for taking care of the Government House, & on the 15th Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Francis Calland Esquire collector of Taxes for the City of Baltimore, seventy four dollars forty two cents for Tax due on Hand Warehouses &c. &c.
