of Tobacco for Interest on \$15,200 purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and
Lot up to the first day of April last. ~ and certificates of Stock was
issued as requested, bearing interest at the rate of five per Centum per Annum
from the first day of April last.

for recording chancery papers under contract with the Executive by Virtue of
Resolutions of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Hobbs
or order five hundred and sixty six dollars eighty two cents for recording
chancery papers under contract with the Executive, by Virtue of Resolutions
of the General Assembly.

June 16th 1827

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William
Beal or order seven hundred and four dollars eighty two cents for
recording chancery papers under contract with the Executive by Virtue
of Resolutions of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George
Brown or order six hundred and forty five dollars two cents for recording
chancery papers under contract with the Executive by Virtue of Resolutions
of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph
May or order four hundred and twenty two dollars sixty four cents for
