Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Harney Esquire or order two hundred dollars for one quarter salary as Auditor General due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Brown of Benjamin or order one hundred and forty six dollars twenty four cents for balance of one quarter salary as Examiner General due the first Instant (after deducting the amount of fees received) & amount.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Thomey Esquire or order seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as Annouer at Easton due the first Instant.
