

July 17 1827.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John White Esquire Cashier of the Office of the Bank of the United States in Baltimore, or order thirty seven dollars eighty one cents out of the net proceeds arising from the inspection of Tobacco for duty on \$3025 purchased money of Edward Warhouse and set up to the first instant.

July 23<sup>d</sup> 1827.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to a certain William Gray, in account of causing the death of a certain Ben Thurg by permitting his horse to mow it unlawfully, which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court at June Term last, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years. (See Pardon Record)

His Excellency also granted a pardon to a certain John Johnson in account of "Arson", for which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court at June Term last. (See Pardon Record)

July 24<sup>th</sup> 1827

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a full Pardon to a certain William Martin, in account of stabbing Frederick Kemp some time in October 1825, for which an indictment was pending against him in Frederick County Court. (See Pardon Record)

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Wilson & Nichol Esquire or order fifty dollars for one quarter salary for taking care of the Government House &c due the 15<sup>th</sup> instant.

August 7 1827.

The following Order was issued by His Excellency the Governor upon the demand and information and evidence therein mentioned viz The State of Maryland To the Sheriff of Washington County Greeting. Whereby it appears from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency John Andrew Shultz Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain Elijah Morris late of the County of Franklin in the said State, stands charged with the crime of Horse Stealing alleged to have been committed in the said County of Franklin, and that he has fled from the Justice of the said State of Pennsylvania into this State, and is now in your custody. And Whereby the said John Andrew Shultz Governor as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Elijah Morris of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice as aforesaid, and appointed the said William Nixon of the aforesaid County of Franklin his agent to receive the said fugitive, and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the said offence, according to Law. - Now, therefore, proper to comply with the said demand, and do hereby order and direct that you forthwith deliver the said Elijah Morris, fugitive as aforesaid,
