Ordered that Captain William Willy deliver to Captain Jacob Ebaugh the Security Rifle heretofore loaned him for the use of the company under his command, for the use of the company commanded by the said Ebaugh.

Ordered that the Clerk of the Council, on or after the 10th instant, draw on the Treasurer of the Western Shore for such sum as may then be in the Treasury on account of the inspection of Tobacco, in favor of Aaron Pearson Superintendent of the building of a Tobacco Inspection Warehouse.
