The following Order was issued this day by His Excellency the
Governor, upon the demand and information and evidence therein mentioned.
viz The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Harford County, Greeting.

Whereas it appears from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive
Department of this State, by His Excellency John Andrew Shultz Governor of the
State of Pennsylvania that a certain David Gilbert late of the County of Adams
in the said State stands charged by indictment of a Grand Jury with fornication and
bastardy, alleged to have been committed in the said County of Adams, and that he
has fled from the Justice of the said State of Pennsylvania into this State, and that it
is believed he is now resident within your jurisdiction. And whereas the said
John Andrew Shultz Governor as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority
given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the
said David Gilbert of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice as
aforesaid, and appointed James Bowen of the Borough of Gettysburg his agent to
receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania
for trial for the said offence according to Law. Now therefore, I Joseph
Kent Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought proper, in compliance
with the said demand, to order and direct the arrest and delivery of the said
fugitive, and do hereby order and direct that you forthwith arrest the said
David Gilbert, fugitive as aforesaid, if he is to be found within your bailiwick,
and deliver him to the said James Bowen, agent as aforesaid, to the said
agent first paying all costs of the arrest, detention &c of the said fugitive. in
for all which this shall be your sufficient Warrant.
