

July 16th 1828.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Writ of Habeas Corpus to a certain Benjamin J. Smy, on account of a charge of Manslaughter for which he has been recognized to appear and answer before Baltimore City Court.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Nathaniel Watson, James Mosher, Nathaniel Williams and Zachariah Woolen Guardians of Robert Watson, or order thirty seven dollars fifty cents, for six months interest, from the first day of January last, to the 30th ultimo inclusive, upon certificate of stocks held by them for the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lot.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Nathaniel Watson, James Mosher, Nathaniel Williams and Zachariah Woolen Guardians of Henry Watson, or order thirty seven dollars fifty cents, for six months interest, from the first day of January last to the 30th ultimo inclusive, upon certificate of stocks held by them for the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lot.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Columbus and John O'Donnell or order one hundred and eighteen dollars seventy five cents, for one quarter interest, up to the first instant, upon certificate of stocks held by them for the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lot.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Columbus and Sarah Cherry O'Donnell, or order seventy five dollars, for one quarter interest up to the first instant, upon certificate of stocks held by them for the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lot.

July 2nd 1828.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Nelson Nichols or order fifty dollars for one quarter salary, up to the fifteenth instant for taking care of the Government House.
