Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Peter Force
or order ten dollars for the Daily National Intelligencer from the 21st day of
March 1828, to the 2nd day of March 1829, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay John W
Whittington or order four dollars & twenty five cents, for binding nineteen
copies of the acts of the last Session of the General Assembly for the Clerks of the
several Counties, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Jeremiah
Lange or order two hundred and forty dollars twenty seven and half cents,
viz \$24 for 300 blank bonds for duty for the incentive, \$10 for printing
circulas letters, with act of Assembly, respecting Tobacco Inspection, \$14 for
advertising for proposals for distributing the Laws &c, \$30 for printing 75
circulas containing five acts of Assembly and Resolutions, accompanying
them, \$3 for advertising for proposals to print the Laws, \$37.50 for
publishing four acts of Assembly and Resolutions respecting them, and for
news paper containing said Laws and Resolutions, directed to the different
printers, agreeably to Resolution of the General Assembly, \$119 for 119 copies
of the Laws of the last Session to supply additional offices, agreeably to
Resolution of the General Assembly, \$8 for 80 lb Lead for weights to
windows in Library rooms, \$6.87 1/2 for stationery for the Treasurer, and
\$1 for advertising for proposals for a Loan & amount allowed.

Clements or order one hundred and twenty dollars for six months Pension
due the first day of April last.

August 18th 1828.
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Lawson
Newman or order six thousand dollars on account of building Ware-
house for the inspection of Tobacco, to be accounted for.

August 26th 1828.
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Henry
Thompson or order fifty nine dollars for balance due him for delivering the
Laws and Notes, and Proceedings to the Clerks of the several Counties
