The following Writ was issued by His Excellency the Governor upon the demand and information and evidence therein mentioned by the State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of any County in this State, Whereas it appears from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency John Andrew Schulze Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain Dennis Lacey late of the County of Adams in the said State, stands charged by indictment of the Grand Jury with fornication and bastardy, alleged to have been committed in the said County of Adams, and that he has fled from the Justice of the said State of Pennsylvania into this State, and that it is believed he is now resident in the City of Baltimore. And Whereas the said John Andrew Schulze Governor as aforesaid, hath in pursuance of the authority given in such case by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Dennis Lacey of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, as aforesaid, and appointed James Bowen of the Borough of Gettysburg his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the said offence, according to Law. Now, therefore, I Joseph Kent Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought proper in compliance with the said demand, to order and direct the arrest and delivery of the said fugitive, and do hereby order and direct that you forthwith arrest the said Dennis Lacey fugitive as aforesaid, if he is to be found in your bailiwick, and deliver him to the said James Bowen agent as aforesaid, he the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest, detention &c of the said fugitive. For all which this shall be your sufficient Warrant.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the said State this fifth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight, and of the Independence of the United States the fifty third.
