On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council, Thomas T. Summons Esquire, was appointed Register of Wills of Anne Arundel County, and commissions issued to him accordingly.

A Return of the Deaf and Dumb in Caroline County, being received, and the Levy Court of the said County, having recommended the selection of Sarah Council, one of the said Deaf and Dumb, to receive the benefit of the act passed at the last Session of the General Assembly providing for the Education of the indigent Deaf and Dumb of this State, His Excellency the Governor selected the said Council, accordingly, and directed that she be sent to the Pennsylvania Institution to be educated, as provided by the said Act.

A Return of the Deaf and Dumb in Charles County, being received, and the Levy Court of said County, having recommended the selection of Samuel Adams, one of the said Deaf and Dumb, to receive the benefit of the act passed at the last Session of the General Assembly providing for the Education of the indigent Deaf and Dumb of this State, His Excellency the Governor selected the said Samuel Adams, accordingly, and directed that he be sent to the Pennsylvania Institution to be Educated as provided for by the said Act.
