

November 19th 1828.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Mills of Dorchester fifteen dollars for one quarter Rent of Magazine, due the 3<sup>d</sup> Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Bostup Summons or order thirteen dollars fifty cents for six months service in cleaning the public Complex up to the first Instant.

The Governor and Council having from the Treasurer of the Western Shore had a day advertised, as usual for proposals to lend to the State the funds necessary to pay in the State Stock of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company the first advance and certain instalments called for by the Company, and that none had been made to him, although the time limited in his advertisement has expired — do consent and advise, that he pay the said advance and such instalments as have been or may be from time to time lawfully demanded and become due, by issuing of State Stock for the same, irredeemable for fifteen years, and to bear the said interest from and after the end of the first twelve months, as authorized by Chapter 105 of December Session 1827.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Lawson Newman Esq. Contractor for building a Steam Gravel house or boiler three thousand five hundred dollars, to be accounted for; and that the said Newman be authorized to borrow six thousand five hundred on account of said building.
