Interest upon certificate of stock held by them for the purchase of Tobacco
Warehouse and Co. due the first instant.

December 5th 1828

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Harvey
late Auditor or over one hundred and thirty three dollars thirty three cents, for
two months salary as Auditor due the first instant.

December 16th 1828.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry
Thompson or over seventy nine dollars for the purchase of firewood, to be accounted
for.

December 17 1828.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to a
certain Elijah Prock on account of a Felony which he was convicted in Baltimore
City Court at the November Term last. (See Pardon Record).

His Excellency also this day granted a commutation of punishment to
Negro Charles, Slave of Elizabeth B. (Kirkman), on account of an assault
and Battery with intent to murder, for which he was convicted in Charles County
Court, at August Term last, and for which he was sentenced to be sold out of the
State. (See Pardon Record)

His Excellency also this day granted a Pardon to a certain
Samuel Gudson, on account of Horse Stealing, for which he was convicted in
Baltimore City Court on the seventh day of March 1823, and sentenced to
the penitentiary for seven years. (See Pardon Record).

Friday December 26 1828.

This being a day appointed for a meeting of the Council

Saturday December 27 1828.

The Council met. Present

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to a certain
Jacob N. Yakey, on account of an assault & Battery on the body of William
R. King, for which he was convicted in Frederick County Court, at October
Term last, and for which he was sentenced to pay a fine of seventy dollars and
undergo a confinement of sixty days in the common jail.
