Wednesday January 10th 1829.  
This being the day appointed by the Constitution and Form of Government for the Election of a Council to the Governor, the General Assembly proceeded to said Election, when Thomas Davis Esquire of Montgomery County, Rezin Estep Esquire of Anne Arundel County and Luke Kerlan Esquire of the City of Baltimore Littleton Smith Esquire of Somerset County and Thomas Thomas Esquire of Cecil County were duly elected.

Saturday January 10th 1829.  
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Moses Sheppard or his Assigns four hundred and twenty five dollars for six months Interest due the first Instant upon Certificate of Stock held by them for the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lot.

Thursday January 15th 1829.  
His Excellency Daniel Martin, Governor Elect, appeared this day in the Senate Chamber, and in the presence of both Houses of the General Assembly, qualified by taking the Oath prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of this State, and the Constitution of the United States, and subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion. And, thereupon His Excellency appeared in the Council Chamber.

The Honorable Rezin Estep, member of the Council Elect, appeared this day and qualified in the manner and form prescribed by the Constitution and Form of Government, and the Laws of this State and Constitution of the United States, as a member of the Council.

Friday January 16th 1829.

attended this day.

Saturday January 17th 1829.  
His Excellency Daniel Martin Governor attended this day.

Monday January 19th 1829.  
His Excellency Daniel Martin Governor attended this day.
