Gentlemen of the Senate and
of the House of Delegates,

In compliance with the request of His Excellency John Forsyth, Governor of the State of Georgia, we had the honor to lay before you a report adopted by the Legislature of that State on certain Resolutions of South Carolina and Ohio touching the fundamental principles of the Federal Government, the sovereignty of the States, causes of complaint for infractions of the Constitution, and encroachments of the General Government upon State rights, as well as the rights of the States to redress their wrongs.
