Executive Department

Annapolis February 4th 1829.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

In reply to your request of this day to be informed who is the Principal Super-intendant of primary schools in this State, and if any appointed, who he is, and what duties, he has performed for the last year. We have the honor to state that Littleton S. Fackler Esquire, was appointed by the Executive on the 15th day of March 1828, Super-intendant of public instruction, and that his resignation of that office was received at this Department on the 29th day of December last. The vacancy thus created has not been filled.

No report having been made to this Department by Mr Fackler we are not advised as to what duties he performed within the last year.
