Ordered that the following public acts which have been passed during the present Session of the General Assembly, viz
"An Act to prevent the unnecessary accumulation of costs upon State files"

"A further Supplement to the act entitled an act for the relief of sundry Insolvent Debtors passed at November Session 1825 Chapter 117."

"A Supplement to the act entitled an act to regulate the issuing of Licenses to traders, keepers of Ordinaries and others passed at December Session 1829 Chapter 117"

"A Supplement to the act entitled an act to authorize the Governor and Council to appoint the inspectors of Flour of this State passed at December Session 1826 Chapter 174" - be published three times in the Maryland Republican, and that the Editor of the said paper send one copy thereof containing the aforesaid acts to every printer of a Newspaper within the State and furnish the Executive with twenty copies of the said acts separate from the newspaper.
