Ordered that the Clerk of the Council request the Opinion of the Attorney General, whether or not, the Executive are authorized to remit the portion of any fine, which the Law imposing, declares shall go to an informer.

By the petition of George Firebaugh, accompanied by a transcript from the Record of Allegany County Court, it appears that he was fined by the said Court, at October Term 1828, the sum of ten dollars for selling liquors without Licence.

The Petitioner states that he has been for a year disabled by sickness from pursuing his usual avocations, and that he was not able to attend at Court, or employ counsel at the trial of his cause. And the Court having recommended the case of the petitioner to the favorable interposition of the Executive. — We do hereby remit the said fine.

By the petition of John Madlow, accompanied by a transcript from the Record of Baltimore County Court, it appears that he was fined by the said Court, at September Term 1828, the sum of fifty dollars for selling dry goods without Licence. The Petitioner states that the said fine was for selling a common sort of domestic make without a Licence, under the Act of the last Session of the General Assembly, that having been in the habit of selling such domestic goods, being licensed as a retailer of liquors, and understanding that he might, under such licence, receive in a March last, sell any domestic goods, he did so ignorant that by so doing he was violating any Law, or exposing himself to any fine, and, therefore, in tender consideration for the innocent manner in which he has offended, he prays to be released from the said fine. And the Court having recommended a compliance with the prayer of the petitioner, — we do hereby remit the said fine, so far as the same is payable to the State.
