

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Gideon Pearce, Clerk to the House of Delegates, ~~in~~ ~~the~~ ~~sum~~ ~~of~~ ~~seventy~~ ~~five~~ ~~dollars~~, for one quarters salary due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the order of Louis Gapaway, Clerk to the Senate, Thirty seven dollars and fifty Cents, for one quarters salary, due this day.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a pardon to Solomon O. Keale, convicted by Montgomery County Court at March Term 1829, of stealing and carrying away a Bay Mare the property of Abraham Stevenson. (See pardon record.)

Also a pardon to William O. Keale (of Sally) convicted by Montgomery County Court at same Term of passing counterfeit money. (See pardon records.)

April 3rd.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Jonathan Hollow, Armorer at the City of Annapolis, ninety one dollar, sixty six and two third Cents viz. \$83.33 $\frac{2}{3}$ for two months salary as Armorer, and, \$8.33 $\frac{1}{3}$ for two months allowance for taking care of the Public property.

April 6th.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of James & Alexander Sheron Eighteen dollars, seventy five Cents for for one quarters interest on \$1500. of State 5 p. Ct. Tobacco Inspection Loan, due 1st inst. (payable by endorsement to David Maynard Cashr.)

April 6th.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the order of Julius Brutus Booth, Eighteen dollars, seventy five Cents, for three quarters interest on \$500. State 5 p. Ct. Tobacco Inspection Loan due first inst. (payable by endorsement to David Maynard Cashr.)

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Ralph Basib One dollar twenty five Cents for sweeping chimneys at Government Hoops to this date.

April 8th.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Samuel Thomas Armorer at Easton, twenty five dollars, for one quarter, Salary to this State.
