

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Charles Curran of Carrollton, or order for one thousand, four hundred and eighty, eight dollars and one cent, in redemption of the principal and interest up to the 25<sup>th</sup> Instant, of a certificate of State 5<sup>th</sup> Cent Stock held by him, on account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lots.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay the Visitors and Governors of Washington College or order one thousand nine hundred and seventeen dollars and twenty two cents, in redemption of the principal and interest up to the 25<sup>th</sup> Instant, of a certificate of State 5<sup>th</sup> Cent Stock held by him, on account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lots.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Doctor William B Selden or order two thousand six hundred dollars and seventy cents, in redemption of the principal and interest up to the 25<sup>th</sup> Instant, of a certificate of State 5<sup>th</sup> Cent Stock held by him, on account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lots.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Pardon to James Haury (free negro) on account of Larceny of a Key of the Value of three dollars; of which he was convicted in Washington County Court, at March Term 1832. (See Pardon Record).

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Pardon to Prognio to Nicholas Nory on account of several Indictments pending against him in Anne Arundel County Court, having been removed for trial, from Baltimore City Court charging him with official Mis-conduct, as a Justice of the Peace. His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Pardon to Charity Bartley negro, on account of maliciously killing her infant child by cutting its throat; of which she was convicted in Baltimore City Court, February Term 1832. (See Pardon Record).

April 19<sup>th</sup> 1832

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to Jefferson Sider on account of several cases of Forgery and counterfeiting and passing forged and counterfeit notes; of which he was convicted in City Court, on the 16<sup>th</sup> Instant. (See Pardon Record).
