Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Hughes or order Seventeen hundred and fifty nine dollars, viz, \$1700 for printing 1600 Copies of the Laws of December Session 1831, \$9 for packing Laws & Journals, and \$50 for printing a Report of the Committee of Ways & Means to be distributed with the Laws, & contract, and amount approved and paid.

Ordered that the Armourer at Frederick, deliver to Captain William Small or order sixty muskets and accoutrements, for the use of the Company under his command.

Ordered that the Armourer at Frederick deliver to Captain Samuel Carmack or order sixty Rifles and accoutrements, for the use of the Company under his command.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted pardons to the following persons viz.

To William Turnor alias John Smith, on account of a crime which he was convicted, at New Term Instant.

To Richard Boston, on account of Stealing Land & Arson, which he had been convicted, at March Term 1820, of the Montgomery County Court, and for which he was sentenced to thirteen years imprisonment in Penitentiary.
