

To *Thomas Riley*, on account of *stealing*; of which he was convicted in *Baltimore City Court*, at *June Term 1831*, and sentenced to the *Penitentiary* for *four years*.

To *Samuel Samson*, on account of *stealing*; of which he was convicted in *Baltimore City Court*, at *November Term 1825*, and for which he was sentenced to the *Penitentiary* for *two years*.

To *Nelson Snyder*, on account of *stealing*; of which he was convicted in *Washington County Court*, at *November Term 1827*, and for which he was sentenced to the *Penitentiary* for *five years*.

To *Darkey Lilly*, on account of *Felony*; of which she was convicted in *Baltimore City Court*, at *February Term 1828*, and for which she was sentenced to the *Penitentiary* for *five years*.

To *Edmond Cutshaw*, on account of *stealing*; of which he was convicted in *Washington County Court*, at *November Term 1827*, and for which he was sentenced to the *Penitentiary* for *five years*.

To *Ned Ege*, free negro, on account of *stealing*; of which he was convicted in *Carroll County Court*, at *October Term 1831*, and for which he was sentenced to the *Penitentiary* for *two years*.

To *Lewis Burge*, free negro, on account of *stealing*; of which he was convicted in *Fredrick County Court*, at *May Term 1832*, and for which he was sentenced to the *Penitentiary* for *two years*.

To *Thomas Wilson*, free negro, on account of *stealing* one *log of wood*, of the value of *twelve and a half pence*; of which he was convicted in *Ducess County Court*, at *May Term 1832*.
