Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Green or order one hundred and six dollars for printing blank forms for the Adjutant General, amount approved and paid.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Cook or order eighty five dollars fifty cents for Boxes to pack Laws and Notes and Proceedings in, amount approved and paid.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Kitzely or order two dollars fifty cents for expensy in sending away and receiving books, amount approved and paid.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Johnson, Clerk of the Court of Appeals for the Western Shore, or order two hundred and fifty dollars for making an Alphabetical Index of the Entries of Cases for Saint Marys County, as required by Law.

June 28th 1832.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Green or order three hundred and twenty seven dollars twenty seven cents for one quarter ^{Postage} from the 1st of April last for the Executive, Adjutant General and Treasurer, viz \$79.49 for the Executive, \$234.34 for the Adjutant General and \$13.44 for the Treasurer amount approved.
